Old Business: Climate Action Plan – discussion of transportation and electrification. Construction of OAT phases 3 & 4 are underway.

New Business: PTO discussion of the Chestnut/732 intersection. Would pedestrian beacons be needed at this intersection? Sam will give an update on the Multi-Modal Transportation Hub at a future meeting. College/Elm on-street parking proposal. Geoff gave a description of the project, which includes kiosks or smart meters on the 200 block of W. High St. (South side), the 0 block of S. Elm St. (East and West sides), 200 block of W. Walnut (North and South sides), and the 300 block of W. Walnut (no parking between 4-5.30 AM). This would be 10 hour parking at \$.25/hour. Carla is willing to attend a stakeholder meeting including OCAC. Move to adopt the proposal – David. 2nd – Jon. Motion passed.

Safe Routes to Schools discussion. Talawanda is updating their transportation plan. Sam sees this as a school district issue. SRTS review: there is a desire for bikeable/walkable schools in town. 80% of Kramer



students live less than 2 miles from school. The Locust/Church intersection needs pedestrian optimization. OAT will provide SRTS on 732. There will be pedestrian beacons on 732 at Dana Dr. Infrastructure, signal timing, education, and enforcement are the elements of STRS. A walk audit is proposed to help identify problem areas. Carla, David, and Jon can work on the audit.

Goals for 2024 Transportation Plan. Funding for this has not been approved by Council yet. Sam distributed a list of potential projects; they need to be prioritized and have the costs updated.
