1. Minutes from the April 10, 2023, meeting

Old Business

David discussed the walk audit with Scott Otto and John Jones. The following intersections were audited: 732 and Chestnut, 732 and Dana, Church and Locust, High and Locust. The trail crossing at Dana/732 is problematic. There was discussion of the speed limit on 732; Oxford can appeal to ODOT for a lower speed limit. Discussion of vehicular flow prioritization.

Sam discussed the future Amtrak station. The property swaps are not working out smoothly. Amtrak has applied for money to make the Cardinal a daily train. Carla will ask Jessica if a letter of support from OPTAB would be helpful for any Amtrak/3C projects. There was a question

concerning the square footage of the Nelson-Morrow building (8575 sf according to the Butler County Auditor).

New Business

1. Updates from members and staff

2. Discussion: upcoming Long Range Transportation Plan, project goals and scope

Long Range Transportation Plan. In 2024, there are plans to update the LRTP. There will be multiple corridors and intersections to examine: Locust/27/Church, Locust/RR, Main St./OAT staging area. Creating ‘spokes’ for OAT and having a complete streets network are also priorities. Table 10 in the 2006 Thoroughfare Plan needs to be reprioritized. Sam can identify worthy projects not in the Thoroughfare Plan or the Comprehensive Plan. There can be in-house fixes to the ‘dotted lines’ (unfinished projects). Carla and Sam will meet before the next OPTAB meeting to set priorities. Schematics will be funded in 2024.

The group thanked Vince for his service to OPTAB.
