Old Business

Old Business: Grant money and in house fixes are planned for the Long Range Transportation Plan. The LRTP is scheduled to be complete at the end of 2024.

New Business

New Business: Walk auditing work was completed over the summer. The pedestrian signals at Church and Locust have been reprogrammed. A HAWK beacon may be installed after OAT phase 4 is complete. The Rapid Flash Beacon will remain in place; a study would be required before the HAWK beacon installation. Amtrak has applied for funds for daily service on the

Cardinal. Discussion. Sam will email an update on the Nelson-Morrow building status. The City has received a \$150K grant through BCRTA for bicycle and pedestrian planning. Priorities have been determined for bike/pedestrian corridors; the plan is to a Complete Streets change to these corridors. The goal is to have schematic designs completed for the corridors. Discussion. The corridors, in order of priority, are: 1) Locust 2) Chestnut 3) Fairfield/Spring 4) S. Main 5) 27 N to the multi-use path 6) N. Main and 7) Sycamore. Motion to approve the priorities: Lee; 2nd – Rick. Motion passed.

Talawanda/SRS. Carla moved to have an engineering study completed to warrant a HAWK beacon. Rick – 2nd. Motion passed. Scott Davey is starting a program that would have volunteers transport high school students.

OPTAB is waiting for follow-up from the City concerning a leading pedestrian interval at High and Locust.

The paving projects discussion will be tabled until October. How can OPTAB include bike/pedestrian projects within paving?

OAT phase V will be on the October agenda.
