1. Review of Submitted Art for the Municipal Public Art Building Display

Selection of submissions from our call for art.

Start with a logistical discussion of the available wall space and limitations. Narrowed from 53 to 21—goal is 10 to 12. Thanks given to Omar for doing the data management. Starting with the entries that received 5, 4, and 3 votes, which includes 12 entries. Debate about including the

metal work piece; we have selected 11 plus the metal work tree.

We would like to hold a reception for the winners with just the members of PACO.

Jessica will contact the artists and engage them with contracts. Then the non-selected artists will be notified. In early December, we'll meet informally to find the right spots for each piece. In January, the pieces will be hung.

Creative placemaking: Jessica met with Enjoy Oxford about pursuing creative placemaking and received \$5,000 in extra funds for that purpose.

Locations for public art are being measured to make plans for future public art installations.

Bee mural has been discussed with city council and Joe Prescher. Amber will talk to Joe and try to get additional information and determine if PACO can be involved somehow, maybe financially. There may be limitations because uptown Oxford is a historic district.
