Old Business: Bicycle/Pedestrian planning. A schematic design for Locust and Chestnut Streets is planned for 2024. An RFP will go out this winter. Discussion of design. Motion to add High St. from College to Campus to the priority list – Jon. 2nd – Rick. Motion passed.

STRS: The start times at elementary schools have changed from 8 AM to 8.30 AM. Discussion of leading pedestrian signals and traffic around Kramer. ODOT will complete a speed study on 732 from Chestnut to TMS. Justification of a HAWK beacon at Dana Dr. and 732 will need data from this study. Discussion of mapping where TMS students live and who will use the 732/Dana intersection after OAT is constructed along 732.

Paving program: Sam presented the potential paving list for 2024. The projects are focused in the northern portion of the Mile Square. Discussion. Discussion of E/W routes with fewer traffic controls in the Mile Square. This will be an agenda item for the December meeting.



OAT phase V: The City plans to acquire the Nelson-Morrow building by the end of 2023 or implement an alternative construction plan for the Amtrak/BCRTA transit hub. There will be a meeting of the Recreation Board on 13 November at the Lane Library to announce the OAT phase V alignment.

New Business: A proposal to change the fee for vehicles parked in the bike lane was discussed. David and Jon will research other municipalities that have ordinances regarding this subject. Discussion of location of level 3 EV charges. This will be on the December agenda.
