Old Business: RFP for transit design is due to go out this winter. The City will collaborate on land use with Oxford Township, City Council, and Jim Rubenstein. Sam will work on the Transit Plan update with GIS.

Dana/SR 732 intersection: Council set aside \$75K as a placeholder. A request has been made to ODOT for a speed study. City staff is looking into changes to the corridor for traffic calming.

Amtrak: there is still an issue with the Nelson-Morrow building. Lee met with Miami and Talawanda SD. Lee will write a letter on this topic.

Street resurfacing: Bike/pedestrian projects are currently tied to repaving. Conversation with engineering staff to include these projects? Sam will ask Scott Otto or Mike Dreisbach to attend OPTAB. Discussion of daylighting and 4-way stop analysis. If there are particular intersections that are problematic, OPTAB can prioritize them and let the City know.

New Business: David would like to run a student project in the Mile Square for bike/pedestrian safety. Discussion. A client is needed. Carla moved that OPTAB be the client; 2nd – Rick. Motion removed. Sam will talk with Scott Otto about the project.

Bike lane parking violations: Jon and David reviewed standing and parking in the bike lanes. The current ordinance is a traffic offense for inhibiting traffic/travel lane violation. John Jones commented that more enforcement could be helpful and that a new section of municipal code is needed in order to have a specific bike lane violation. John will take with Miami about enforcement.

Regional Climate Action Plan – OKI: OKI has grant money from USEPA. OKI is looking for project ideas for larger grants. Transit-related resilience and mitigation are eligible. Discussion.
