3. Update on the Duke Substation Mural

Duke substation mural.

- Duke would like PACO to wait until 2026 for Spring St. mural installation
- Duke will transfer 10K to PACO. City will encumber funds to 2026.
- Council approved 50K for 2025 for mural. Possible uses: use part of budget this year for other project and carry over rest to 2026; sponsor a grant program for businesses to install public art uptown (business owner would be responsible for the maintenance of the art)

Public art brainstorm: event or location dedicated to youth art; “adopt a square” mural program in an area that is clean and accessible; temporary construction fence art; youth art festival in the summer (classes and activities) associated with April 12th Bee Festival. Art challenge at the bee festival (April 12th).

Possible locations for additional public art: the well on phase 2 of OATS, traffic light posts (High and Beech, High and Poplar), College at Elm (need to chat with Miami), parking garage once repairs are complete.

Jessica will ask Council about the possibility of funding 2 big Art projects 2025 (Garage) 2026 (Duke Substation).

4. Art Support from the Community Foundation

Oxford Community Foundation may be a source of funding for smaller public art projects by students etc.
