1. Green Umbrella Climate Action Fellowship Presentation (Kate Kozak and Oluwaseun Olubodun, Fellows)

Kate Kozak and Oluwaseun Olubodun, Green Umbrella Climate Action Fellows, presented their work for the summer. The slides are attached.

The commission had a robust discussion regarding the value of Green Umbrella's Climate Action Fellowship and how they are excited to see more climate work in the region. Overall, the board was very appreciative and impressed with the fellows' work.

Specific ideas that were discussed further was paper procurement, as Miami is implementing a 30% recycled content requirement for copy paper beginning this fiscal year. For Oxford, the fellows found that increasing our recycled content from 5 to 30% would increase costs disproportionately to the decrease in emissions.

Additionally, the committee discussed the potential for an impervious surface fee and noted that a reduction in fees could be used to incentivize commercial properties to adopt other environmentally friendly measures (i.e. EV Charging, rain gardens, etc).

Mr. Gorchov introduced a motion to recognize the exemplary work from the Green Umbrella Fellows for Oxford's Climate Action Steering Committee and for the City of Oxford. Mrs. Woy-Hazelton seconded and the motion was unanimously approved.
