Old Business: Update on Amtrak. Since the infrastructure bill passed in November, funds are available to study new corridors. Lobbying efforts are needed to get state and local governments moving on new rail corridors. Jon will contact All Aboard Ohio to determine the most efficient lobbying strategy and possibly have AAO present at the next meeting.

The City is negotiating with Talawanda School District to take ownership of the Nelson-Morrow building. Jessica gave an update on these negotiations. Carla moved to recommend that Council explore the swap or lease of the Senior Center for the Nelson-Morrow Building to assist with the Amtrak platform design without the Nelson-Morrow structure in place. 2nd – David. The Thoroughfare Plan may be updated in 2022 or 2023, depending on funding; it could also be part of sub plans in 2023.
