Old Business:

1. New Commission member status

- a. Todd Stewart's application was misrouted but he will officially be presented next meeting.
- b. Associated with this, we might consider changing the meeting time of PACO due to new members calendars but we need to reconsider that classes are ending soon.

2. Murals: Installation of Civil rights mural; LoWV connections

- a. No updates on when Civil Rights mural will be rehung.
 - i. Amber reports Mike Driesbach will be looking at the installation
 - ii. Joe Prescher has the copy right for the mural and has been currently storing it outside. He needs to do restoration and upkeep on it.
 - iii. PACO has made a statement they need the City to get it done in a timely manner, and has offered to pay for the installation.

- iv. Carole asked for a ballpark estimate of timing for restoration. Joe is under the impression there is a window of May for the installation so he is guessing April will be the time for his restoration.
 - v. 5 year contract with minimal maintenance. Joe does not know who is responsible for maintenance and upkeep in the contract. There may be some cap put on it to repel the rain. Need to ask if PACO is included within the contract.
 - b. Steve reported that he connected JC Rupel and the League of Women Voters on a mural. They will work together as private entities.
 - i. Carole will try to reach out for updates to brief PACO
 - ii. Joe had previously created a design for LOWV for the mural.
- 3. Confirmation of OCAC/City MOU on insurance**
- a. The paperwork will be presented to Council on Tuesday the 15th by Jessica Greene.
 - b. OCAC has some logistical questions but it seems like things that have not yet been defined (who is picking the art?)
 - i. PACO is picking the pieces with OCAC representatives
 - ii. How long will shows be up? 6 months according to the call for art
- 4. Review of existing document folder**
- a. Waverly presented the document of tracking documents.
- 5. Presentation of map of possible art sites**
- a. Waverly presented on the map and its functionality.
 - b. Ask future intern to create a map with current art locations, especially when we have more art.
 - c. Add the train station when we know.
- 6. Bike trail painting discussion**
- a. Trying to avoid it feeling like entrapment.
 - b. Jessica has confirmed that if PACO comes up with a design and finds someone to do a painting, that PACO can just go and do the art. The City has given PACO purview over these sites.
 - i. This is creating some confusion on PACO's scope and purview.
 - ii. Does Council have a veto over an aesthetic choice?
 - iii. Doesn't there need to be a call for art? Wouldn't this harm our mission of being an inclusive art environment?
 - 1. Maybe PACO can make it an art event.
 - 2. Joe may submit some designs for the underpass and would love to involve the high school or the middle school.
 - 3. There would not be pay involved though especially for this project. Need to talk to Jessica on how recusal works.
