Updates from the Chair:

- Review of draft language for proposed changes to SCRC composition
 - Staff report outlining specific changes to SCRC composition
 - Amend total voting members from 11 to 8
 - Amend ex-officio members from 12 to 11
 - Amend details of student seats to SCRC
 - Identify SCRC chair as MU ASG Secretary for Off-Campus Affairs
 - Reduce the number of student seats from 5 to 4
 - Require one of the remaining student seats be filled, in alternating years, by a representative of either
 - National Pan-Hellenic Council, or
 - Multicultural Greek Council
 - Amend the number of non-student members from 6 to 4
 - Identify that a Secretary for SCRC will be nominated and chosen



- Review of Walk Audit program
 - Pilot walk audits performed on Collins Ave.
 - General feedback
 - Pedestrian paths in fair to good condition
 - Forms could be improved to give additional space for notes
 - Time went quickly, completed routes in 30 minutes
