Discussion of public art spaces mapping project

- Jessica presented map of publicly owned places for Oxford public art, completed by Eli and Allison (student interns). Will be available on public GIS account
- Discussed City of Oxford summary of research murals. Reviewed, sample contracts, average costs. Need clarification on the costs of materials vs. artist fees. City should require anti-graffiti covering and high paint quality for murals
- Currently there is a pause in the student-led THS NHS mural proposal

Discussion of call for art process

- One option: PACO releases a call for art, city creates a budget, PACO reviews applicants, selected artist is paid artist fee.
- Second option: Artist approaches PACO with a plan and budget. PACO could provide some financial support but not necessarily fund the entire project.
- Contract with artist should specify that PACO must approve detailed design. More structural art needs different levels of review.



- Discussed grant applications for public art (e.g. training with Arts Wave). Perhaps apply for future grants with partners like OCAC and other nonprofits. City would be applicant for grants.

Discussion of “Haikus in Bloom” update

- Carole Katz shared concept for window clings
- Depending on size of window cling, may need permission from Sam Perry
- Any light projection on sidewalk or wall is considered to be a sign
- Ashley can post Call for Haikus on city website
- Get 3 quotes for printing of haiku window clings, City’s graphic designer can design boarder options for PACO to choose from
- Perhaps have Haiku treat Electric Root Festival

Discussion of collaborations with businesses and Enjoy Oxford brainstorm(Kim Daggy and Seth Cropaenbaker)

- Enjoy Oxford newsletters could include info about Call for Haikus for businesses
- Music festival or Red Brick Friday chalk festival
- Haiku bingo cards for people to fill out with business locations for haikus
- Incorporate art in gardens, collaborate with garden clubs

Additional topics raised

- Could PACO funds be used for mini grants or seed money for local projects?
- Could PACO have a small brand or logo?
